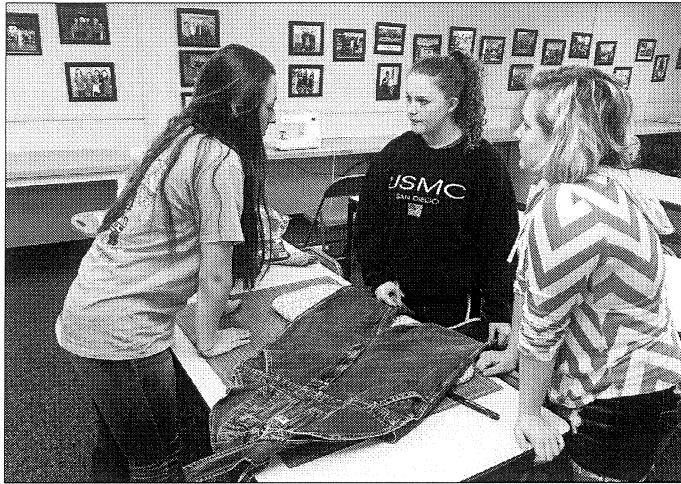
Members of the senior division Rusk County 4-H Duds to Dazzle (D2D) Team met at the Rusk County Extension Office for one final county practice on May 31, before they head to competition at Texas 4-H Roundup in College Station on June 10-14.

Duds to Dazzle is a contest where teams of youth are given a textile to repurpose using only the items in their sewing kits and craft closet, and their knowledge and skills learned in the 4-H Clothing and Textile Project. The repurposed item can be made into a wearable item, an accessory/jewelry item, or a non-wearable item

depending on the category in which the team is placed during the competition.

On the evening of the May

31 practice the 4-H'ers had the task of re-purposing a pair of men's overalls into a wearable apparel.
