

Rusk County Youth Project Show Scholarship Information & Guidelines

- Selection will be based on financial need, interview, RCYPS Involvement, Essay, and Awards/ Community Service.
- Applicants must be graduating high school senior with a minimum GPA of 2.5
- Applicants must be a member in good standing of a Rusk County FFA Chapter or 4-H Club.
- Applicant must attend college or technical school in the fall semester immediately following selection. *(Failure to do so results in a forfeit of the scholarship)*
- Three letters of recommendation must be attached to the application and must be from:
 - 1 from County Extension Agent, Ag Science Teacher, or 4-H Leader
 - 1 from school administrator, teacher, or coach (other than Ag Science teacher)
 - 1 from community member (this could include a RCYPS adult volunteer)
- All above requirements plus signatures on the application are required for a complete application. Points will be deducted for incomplete applications.
- All applications MUST be received by the deadline stated in the application package. Application WILL NOT be accepted after that date.
 - Hard copies must be sealed in an envelope and may be hand delivered to the Rusk County Extension Office.
